- **Entry Deadline.** The entry form must be completed and have a U.S. Post Mark by June 5, 2006 or face a one-time \$15.00 late fee. Draw will be posted to www.ebarrelracing.com & www.lonestararena.com by June 13, 2006.
- **Money and Awards.** Awards will be presented, directly following the race. Any checks not claimed at the conclusion of the weekend, will be mailed to address on the entry form. Any awards not claimed at the conclusion of the weekend, will be mailed COD to the winning person at their request or held for a future pick up.
- **Late Entries.** Late entries will be taken up until the last 25 runners for the Open 5D.
- **Pay-Off.** Payback: 100% of Added Money, 75% of entry. Pay-off will be computed so that last hole in the 5D will win a minimum of their entry and office fee or \$70. Placing Open 5D: 1/2 Second Splits. Percentages Open 5D: 30%, 25%, 20%, 15 %, 10%.
- **One Race 3 Sections.** This will be one race run in 3 sections. You can enter the same horse/rider combination up to 2 times, but must enter in 2 different sections. If you win 2 different D's with the same horse/rider combination, you will be eligible for the dollar earnings, but will only be eligible to win one saddle. If a rider does win 2 saddles on the same horse/rider combo, the rider will keep the saddle won with the fastest time and the second saddle will be awarded to the runner up. A rider can enter as many horses as they like and will be eligible to win a saddle with each of these entries.
- **"Rider Incentive Race"** is a race within the "Main Barrel Race." You only make one run, that run counts toward the "Main Barrel Race" and the "Rider Incentive Race." You do not have to enter the "Rider Incentive." The Incentive races have a \$20 Entry fee - 4D Format - 1/2 second splits. Payback: 100% of Added Money, 75% of entry. Pay-off will be computed so that last hole in the 4D will win a minimum of their entry fee. Percentages for Incentive Races: 30%, 27%, 23%, 20%. Awards will be given for a minimum of 1st in Each D, more awards presented according to total number of entries.
 - Youth Rider - 15 years and younger
 - Adult Rider - 16 - 49 years
 - Senior Rider - 50 years and over
(Riders age based on Jan 1, 2006)
- **Refunds.** A refund will be granted to all contestants for any reason for entry fees, stall fees and RV fees, less a 25% service charge. Refund must be requested at least 1 hour prior to the start of the race on March 17, 2006.
- **Substitutions.** Any horse substitution must be made with the show secretary, in writing, at least 2 hours before your run. You cannot substitute a horse already entered in the race into another draw position.
- **Returned Checks.** There is a \$40 service charge on all returned checks from the bank, for any reason. If a check is not replaced with a cashiers check or money order within 30 days after the check is dated, the contestant will be put on the "ineligible" list.
- **Horses Must Be Stalled.** All horses spending the night must be stalled in a Lone Star Arena Stall. Unstalled horses will be impounded and a fee of \$25 required to release the horse.
- **Dogs.** All dogs must be on a leash at all times. A \$20.00 fine may be assessed for failure to follow these rules.
- **Vendors.** There shall be no selling of any type of merchandise or professional service on the arena grounds, in stalls, or at trailers without a vendor contract with Lone Star Arena.
- **Time.** Any time a contestant crosses the starting line, the time will begin

- **No Time.** A "No Time" will be given to the contestant for the following reasons:
 - a. If the contestant "circles" their horse after entering the arena. (Breaking the plane of the alley)
 - b. If the contestant misses the barrel pattern or stops forward motion.
 - c. If the contestant runs out of turn. It is the contestant's responsibility to know their draw position.
 - d. If a contestant knocks over a barrel. A "no time" will also be given if a barrel is knocked over and it sets up again on either end. Touching a barrel, including keeping it from falling, is permitted without penalty.
 - e. If the contestant's horse or rider falls during the run in such a manner as to break the pattern, or if the rider falls off the horse.
- **Family/Horse.** Contestant's may ride any horse, regardless of ownership. However, more than one person in the barrel race may not show a horse, unless the following conditions are met:
 - a. Both contestants are members of the same immediate family who reside in the same household (husband, wife, children and grandchildren 21 and under). Children and grandchildren 21 and under who are attending school away from home, but who reside part of the year with their parents or grandparents are included under this rule.
 - b. Neither contestant is showing any other horse in that barrel race.
 - c. In no case will the same horse be run more than twice in the same barrel race
- **Re-runs** shall be granted if the timer fails to work properly or if the barrels are not placed properly on their markers. Any penalty incurred on the original run shall not be applied against the re-run; however, any penalty occurring on the re-run shall result in a no time.
- **Ties.** If any contestant's times are tied, the prize money will be split equally and a roll of the dice between the tied contestants will determine the tie for the awards. High roll wins
- The management of Lone Star Arena reserves the right to create any new rule, or modify any existing rule, in order to better the sport or this barrel race.
- **Negative Coggins Required.** Be prepared to show.
